CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT

The curriculum of the School District of Wauzeka-Steuben shall enrich the lives of all students by providing development of skills, processes, and expectations in quality instructional settings. The curriculum will provide an organized set of learning experiences which meet the goals and expectations of the District.

The District's curriculum and instructional programs shall be planned in line with the educational standards adopted by the Board of Education. The development and improvement of curriculum shall be a basic consideration in the attainment of District goals. The primary objective shall be to maintain and improve an articulated K-12 curriculum in all curricular areas. Each course or unit of study should be expressed in terms which identify and/or measure learning outcomes and development for each student.

The District Principal or designee shall be delegated the responsibility of providing leadership and coordination to ensure the development of a comprehensive, sequential curriculum which is reviewed regularly as needed to assure relevancy, timeliness, and appropriateness (including, but not limited to: curriculum revisions, additions, and deletions). This process shall involve teachers, administrators, and other stakeholders in activities which accomplish these ends within a cycle of program renewal.
