SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WAUZEKA-STEUBEN

ART INSTRUCTION

The Board of Education of the School District of Wauzeka-Steuben adopts the following plan for art instruction in the District:

- 1. The art instructor shall submit to the Board, for approval, a comprehensive K-12 art curricula which is based upon concepts developed through sensory awareness, aesthetic discrimination, and skill development in the creation of art and the knowledge of human art heritage.
- 2. Art instruction shall be provided for all students in grades K-4 and shall be performed by or under the supervision of a department certified art teacher.
 - 3. Art instruction shall be available to all students in grades 5 -12 and shall be taught by a department certified art teacher.
 - 4. The art teacher will annually review and submit to the District Administrator a recommendation of the overall art program of the District intended to reflect the interests and needs of the students.
 - 5. Equipment and supplies necessary for appropriate art instruction will be requisitioned and purchased by the District to ensure that the District meets its responsibilities to adequately meet the needs of the art program.
 - 6. The art instructor will be held responsible for duties listed in the District's job description for art teacher.
