GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS – RULE

Graduation Credit Deficiency

1. Parents/Legal guardians of juniors and seniors having a graduation credit deficiency will be notified, as soon as possible after the start of each of the student's last four (4) semesters. A student is considered deficient if s/he needs more than the minimum number of credits to be a full time student in any of the remaining semesters.

2. The notification letter to parents/legal guardians includes information on:
 - A. total credits remaining
 - B. number of semesters remaining
 - C. number of semesters of each type of required class remaining

Students Aides

Student Aide credits will be given their own description in the Course Description Booklet, subject to administrative approval.

Each aide position will be worth .25 credit if performed every day for a semester. No student can earn more than 0.5 credit toward the graduation requirements as an aide, regardless of number or type of positions performed. A student can continue to be an aide after 0.5 credit has been reached; however, any additional work as a student aide will be listed on the student transcript, but not assigned credit.

All aide positions will be a Pass/Fail system of grading. **Each supervising teacher must turn in a grade report at the end of each grade reporting period, outlining Pass/Fail status for the student aide.**

For the purposes of “full-time student” status, no aide position(s) will count as academic credit. Student aides must have a minimum of six (6) other classes to maintain full-time student status.
