STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS

- 1. There shall be no more than one (1) dance scheduled each month of the school year.
- 2. All dances shall end no later than 11:00 p.m. (12:00 a.m. with prior administrative approval)
- 3. Starting time for dances shall be at the discretion of dance advisors (pending administrative approval).
- 4. Any students attending the dance have to arrive before the completion of court. No students will be admitted after 30 minutes into the dance.
- 5. Once a person leaves the building, s/he may not reenter the dance.
- 6. Any student suspected of consuming alcohol and/or using illegal drugs will be excluded from entry to the dance and subject to further discipline.
- 7. Once a student or guest is asked to leave a school dance, s/he shall be excluded from all subsequent dances for the school year.
- 8. The number of chaperones will be at the discretion of the advisor and administration.
- 9. Lighting shall be at the discretion of the chaperone.
- 10. No student under grade 9 shall be admitted to dances unless accompanied by a parent/legal guardian. Younger students may only attend as spectators, and are not allowed to participate in the dance. (*This rule does not pertain to the miniatures*.)
- 11. The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of a student involved in an incident shall be informed.
- 12. The class or organization sponsoring the dance shall arrange for the cleaning of the gymnasium.
