WAUZEKA-STEUBEN SCHOOL DISTRICT

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

A student in the District shall be considered full time if s/he:

- 1. is an elementary or middle school student scheduled in classes for the entire school day; or
- 2. is a high school student scheduled for a minimum of 6 credits of coursework; or
- 3. has been evaluated by the Individual Educational Plan team ((IEP-team) and prescribed an Individual Educational Plan (IEP)); or
- 4. is participating in an alternative educational program or other program or curriculum modifications approved by the student's parent(s)/legal guardian(s) and District officials; or
- 5. is a resident student attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law under a District-paid tuition agreement (including for special education needs) and a tuition waiver under section 121.84 (4) of state statutes.
