SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WAUZEKA-STEUBEN

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES ON SCHOOL PREMISES

- 1. Pursuant to State Stat. 118.258 (1) Each school board may adopt rules prohibiting a pupil from using or possessing an electronic communication device while on premises owned or rented by or under the control of a public school.
- 2. Electronic communication devices that pose a threat to the health and safety of students or staff or create disruption to the learning environment may not be used in the schools or on school property during the school day. Students who violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary procedures as identified in the student-parent/legal guardian handbook(s).
- 3. Students may be allowed to use cell phones and other electronic communication devices for educational purposes and at times and places designated by the building principal as appropriate.
- 4. Pursuant to State Stat. 118.258(2) Annually, if the school board adopts rules under sub. (1), it shall provide each pupil enrolled in the District with a copy of the rules.
