EMERGENCY NURSING SERVICES

Definitions:

“Professional Nurse” is a nurse who has a certificate of registration under s. 441.06 or who is licensed as a registered nurse in a party state, as defined in s. 441.50 (2) (j) who performs for compensation of any act in the observation or care of the ill, injured, or infirm, or for the maintenance of health or prevention of illness of others, that requires substantial nursing skill, knowledge, or training, or application of nursing principles based on biological, physical, and social sciences, herein referred to as the School Nurse.

“Delegation”: the process for a nurse to direct another person to perform nursing tasks and activities.

“Medical Advisor” is a physician licensed to practice in the State of Wisconsin.

The emergency nursing service program shall be under the direction of the District Administrator in collaboration with the District Nurse.

The School District of Wauzeka-Steuben shall contract with a School Nurse currently licensed in the State of Wisconsin from Crawford County Public Health for the purpose of providing consultation on Emergency Nursing Services.

A qualified physician shall serve as Medical Advisor.

The Medical Advisor, in conjunction with a School Nurse, other school district personnel, and representatives from community health agencies, as designated by the Board, shall assist in the annual review of policies and procedures and first aid standing orders/protocols pertaining to the Emergency Nursing Services Program.

Emergency services shall be available during the school day and during all school-sponsored activities, including summer school, same day field trips, extended field trips and out of the country field trips, and athletic events or extra-curricular activities.
