

**SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WAUZEKA-STEUBEN**

**GRADUATING CLASS VALEDICTORIAN**

The purpose of this policy is to set forth the procedures for selection of the graduating class Valedictorian.

1. To be selected as Valedictorian, the student must have earned the highest cumulative GPA at the end of the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) semester in his/her graduating class. The GPA shall be determined by grades received in all high school attendance. Pass/Fail courses are not included in the grade point average.
2. The individual student must have been enrolled in the School District of Wauzeka-Steuben for at least four (4) full semesters immediately prior to graduation.

In the event two or more students are tied, the principal shall declare all such tied students as Co-Valedictorians.

The student(s) ranked second according to the above criteria will be the salutatorian(s).
