STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Students in the District will be informed of all available academic scholarships and awards in a timely manner. Literature concerning these scholarships and awards will be available in the counselor's office. Criteria for scholarships and awards shall be spelled out in these notices.

The guidance department will maintain a record of available scholarships and will notify students of scholarship opportunities in a timely manner as they arise during periods of the school year when this information is most useful.

In order for a high school student to be eligible for local scholarships, the student must have been enrolled for the two complete semesters of his/her senior year. To be eligible for consideration of the State of Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship, students must be enrolled in Wauzeka-Steuben High School for two (2) complete semesters prior to February 15th of the year in which s/he graduates (the selection date for the scholarship). (See Policy #461)

The District shall not discriminate in the acceptance or awarding of gifts, bequests, scholarships or other aids, benefits, or services to students from private agencies, organizations, or persons on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, color, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability, or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
